## CURRICULUM HIGHLIGHTS

Students, families and parishioners participate in school-sponsored rosaries, masses, novenas, Stations of the Cross and weekly Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which demonstrate an outward sign of our "community of faith." Students participate in service projects for the church community by making Advent ornaments for the church's Advent tree and collecting food for the Food Bank, which serves the needy in our community.

## STUDENT ACTIVITIES

A wide variety of activities encourage students to practice good stewardship toward one another, as well as, the greater Catholic community. Seasonal service projects provide students with a sense of participation in the Catholic mission of actively living one's faith. ## PHILOSOPHY STATEMENT

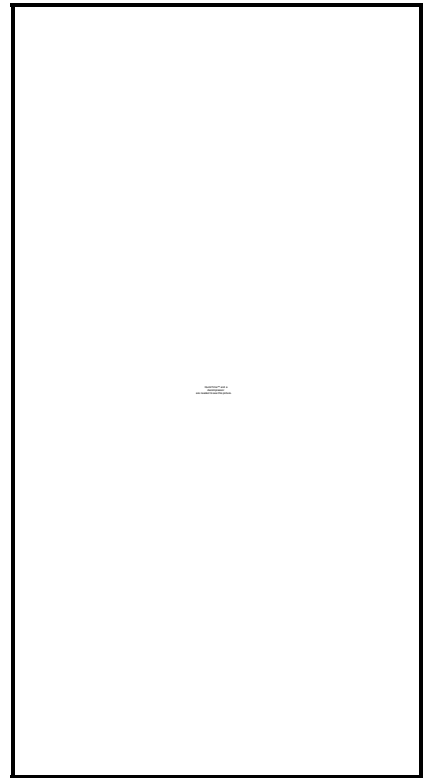
