Fund Raisers

\$215,000 raised last school year without asking our kids to go door-to-door selling candy bars and wrapping paper.

For the last several years All Souls Home & School has kept fund raising to a minimum. We concentrate on 2 major fundraisers throughout the year:

Silent Auction

This is our only major fund raising event each year and provides the largest source of income for All Souls Home & School. The event includes a dinner, silent auction and live auction. Last year we raised more than \$200,000.

This year's theme is Celebrate Americana and will be held on November 10. We encourage a variety of donations to the silent and live auctions as well as attendance to this great event. We need lots of volunteers in all areas to make this event a success.

Gift Cards

This is a year round program that produces a substantial amount of income without any donation requirements from participants. Simply purchase gift cards for use at King Soopers, Safeway, Whole Foods and Tony's to purchase groceries, movie tickets, lift tickets, dining cards, etc. The school receives 5% of all gift cards sold.

We raised over \$15,000 last year and have set a goal of \$60,000 for this year. We have high expectations that this fund raiser will continue to grow and provide us with a great deal of additional funds.

Our Mission

All Souls Home & School Association is a parent volunteer organization that works with the administration and teachers to enhance the school experience and the spirit of the Christian community for the students at All Souls. There are many and varied opportunities for parents (and parishioners) to become involved in the school. Finally, we assist the school financially with "wish list" items, not funded by the school, that serve to improve the quality of the children's education.

So what exactly does Home & School do with the money raised?

Funds distributed last year:

\$20,000 + to the teacher endowment fund.

\$20,000 + to help All Souls families in financial need.

\$50,000 contributed to the technological fund that ensures we have money available to keep up with the needs and changes in technology.

\$30,000 + given to the All Souls staff for a Christmas bonus.

\$50,000 held in a trust to balance the school budget.

\$20,000 for all new tile and baseboards for the primary classrooms to match the new addition.

\$10,000 in tithing to a poorer parish for a new boiler.

\$10,000 for new TVs.

\$9,000 + for new athletic uniforms for basketball, JV baseball and volleyball.

\$5,000 + for books, supplies and shelves for the library.

\$6,000 for defibrillators.

\$1,500 for CPR/1st aid training.

Currently installing a new sound system for the gym.

In September, we will be purchasing new computers for the teachers.

\$5,000 for the Fast Direct system used school wide for e-mail, grades, etc.
