<i>Total Monthly Grocery Bill</i>		<i>Earnings</i>		<i>All Souls Earns</i>
\$800	x	5%	=	\$40

**Imagine** the fund-raising possibilities...if 150 of our All Souls families (less than half of the families) contributed \$40/month (pain-free through their grocery bills) to All Souls...this would be **\$6000/month...\$72,000/year!** Tuition assistance, computers, smart boards, teacher bonuses, facilities, etc...
